Monthly Projects Update – November 2023

Moonta Road

- Request for quote sent out to selected contractors suitable for designing the road, stormwater and kerb
- Project awarded to Be Engineering Solutions
- Stage 1 Design will see Moonta Road from Haylock Road to East Terrace have a full design undertaken
- Council employees to meet on site to discuss requirements, expectations and technical details with Be Engineering in late October



Moonta Road – Survey Completed

Lawrence Street Footpath - Kadina


- Lawrence Street Footpath has been completed from cul-de-sac to public toilets
- Further works on Lawrence Street will only commence on the completion of required property sewer connections and kerb installation





<u>Gawler Street Flood Mitigation – Kadina</u>

- Design completed in house by Council Engineers to save on project cost.
- Tender to be submitted on the Tenders SA portal open for bidding, closing by late November
- Tender will be awarded late November, early December
- Successful contractor will start works in 2024
- Council received funding from the Stormwater Management Authority from the Kadina Stormwater Management Plan



Randolph Street Flood Mitigation – Port Hughes

- Start-up meeting with Nova Group representatives, Holiday Park Management and Council staff occurred early October
- Nova Group have ordered pits, pipes and other materials required for the job, a lead time of 8-12 weeks has been given for these materials
- Due to school holidays and Christmas period, Nova Group expect to commence works in late January/early February
- Council staff are liaising with local contractors regarding required service relocations within the excavation line



<u>Reseal</u>

- Copper Coasts 22/23 program was combined with the 23/24 program that commenced late September
- Fulton Hogan have worked through the first stage of the program in Kadina and Wallaroo having now mobilized to Moonta
- Contractor expects to complete all seals in the Copper Coast by the end of October pending weather delays.
- In total, 110,000 square meters of reseals to be completed



Dalrymple Street, Matta Flat, Road Reseal

East Terrace/John Olsen Road, Kadina

- Stage one of stormwater improvements throughout East Terrace are complete
- The existing basin has had an increase in capacity and an additional connecting junction box to reduce to flow rate downstream relieving pressure on existing underground infrastructure
- The basin was finished with rock to assist in reducing debris into the network and help improve the water quality.
- Contractor worked around and with existing semi-established vegetation to reduce the need to remove them



East Terrace/John Olsen Stormwater Upgrade, Kadina East

Kadina Racecourse Grandstand

- Contractors removed the identified friable asbestos within the walls used as lagging around water pipes
- Demolition of the remaining structure was cleared to recommence early October, Council staff undertook this demolition
- Rock material from the walls is to be sieved and separated and utilized for the cemetery
 walls with the unwanted remnants to be added to our crushing stockpiles that are used
 on rural roads





Moonta Bay Accessible Ramp and Revetment Wall

- Works on the revetment wall have gone as far as they can for now, until the accessible ramp is constructed
- Request for quotes sent to suitable contractor for installation of all accessible ramp
- Fabrication of the ramp has been completed and sent to site awaiting installation
- Redesign of the accessible ramps footing has been completed with installation of these footings to commence early to mid-November
- Concrete footings installed for new aluminum steps that are to installed in front of the Moonta Bay Caravan Park

Wallaroo Holiday Park Re-roof

- Re-Roofing of the existing Kohler Cabins on the front row are continuing
- Three cabins have been completed to date
- Remaining cabins will continue to be scheduled inn for re-roofing as bookings and scheduling allow



Wallaroo Holiday Park - CWMS Upgrade

- Contractor SADB (South Australia Directional Boring) began works on the upgrade early October
- Pre investigation of property connections undertaken to confirm drill depths that cleared all services.
- Drillers have installed an approximate 500m of new sewer pump line

- Civil crew excavated 5 entry exit holes and completed 2 link ups
- SAPN provided us with a NAP on Friday, 13 October 2023, we confirmed the HV in the holiday park.
- Ground investigations around the existing pump station in the park have been undertaken in preparation for this stage of the upgrade




