What is Not a Local Nuisance

As per the *Local Nuisance and Litter Control Act, Schedule 1, Part 3 Section 5*, the following does <u>not</u> constitute a Local Nuisance and in some cases, may be covered and reported under a different Act or Regulations:

- Any approval (consent, licence, permit or entitlement) granted under any other Act or Legislation
- Licensed premises
- Fireworks displays
- Sporting or associated activities at sporting venues
- Community events run by or on behalf of a Council (subject to any conditions imposed by Council)
- Public infrastructure works
- Noise from vehicles (other than vehicles operating within, or entering or leaving a business premises)
- Subject of legal proceedings under
 - o The Community Titles Act 1996 or
 - The Strata Titles Act 1988 or
 - The Residential Tenancies Act 1995
- Music or voices or both resulting from an activity at domestic premises
- Activities carried on in the normal course of a school kindergarten child care centre or place of worship
- Aircraft or railway noise
- Emergency vehicles sirens
