# Monthly Projects Update - March 2023

### Moonta Road, Moonta Stormwater Upgrade

- Council's contractor MA Skinner have commenced work on the stormwater upgrade through the Moonta Road open swale drain.
- This project will improve stormwater drainage in the area and will become the main stormwater drainage for the surrounding areas.
- Current works include installing culverts running parallel to Moonta Road and across Coast Road. This will improve stormwater flows under the road as well as installing new side entry pits near the road for future stormwater collection.
- Fencing and vegetation is being removed as part of the upgrade, this will be reinstated at a later stage.



### Port Hughes Jetty Maintenance

- Council approached Maritime Constructions to undertake some minor routine maintenance works on the Port Hughes Jetty.
- This was due to Maritime being in our area with their barge and equipment and to help reduce costs.
- These works included, replacing some old jetty planks, removing some old and rotting wooden piles (non-structural) and increasing stability of some wooden planks.





### Lipson Avenue, Kadina Road Reinstatement

- Following a report to Council of a sinkage in the road at Lipson Avenue near the Wallaroo Mines Primary School, a Council engineer and contractor investigated and excavated the area and found what appeared to be an old drain of some description in this location.
- Due to the large amount of rain that the area has seen it was believed that the area sunk due to the volume of water passing through the old drain.
- Council established a cement stabilised sand base and installed a new and large road ballast drain to allow water flows if they still exist.
- This was then topped off with rubble and was sealed in mid-February.





### Hedonbar Brewery

- All effluent works including pumping station and network connection commissioned and completed.
- Electrical switchboard upgrade commissioned and completed, this included a shutdown of power for 3 days. Limited power supply to the Farm Shed was achieved with a Council generator.
- Fire safety provisions completed and signed off by the office of technical regulator. This included fire hydrants, hose reels and booster assembly.
- Hedonbar staff have begun brewing beer in anticipation of the opening and launch of the brewery.

## Queens Square, Moonta – Accessible Paths

- Exposed aggregate accessible paths are currently being installed over the existing walking paths; these will be complemented with mahogany cobblestone pavers as a border.
- An enlarged area to the parks entrance from George/Henry Street end has been created, as has a linking paths from the public toilets, Sir Richard Williams statue and Rotunda.
- Street furniture including seating and bin enclosures have been ordered as part of the upgrade, expected to arrive in 10-12 weeks.





### Wallaroo to Moonta Shared Path

- The shared path bridges completed within the National Heritage.
- Date is still to be confirmed for sealing of the final sections of path in Moonta Mines.
- Signage & bollards ordered to complete the final section once sealed.
- Last section within Wallaroo township is now sealed and ready for line marking.





#### Kadina Lagoons

- Bulk excavation works to the lagoon wall and basin completed.
- Removal of the soft clay has been achieved and the sub base reinstated with suitable materials.
- Compaction has been achieved across the lagoon with final shaping of the banks and floor underway.
- The liner is scheduled to be installed at the beginning of March.

**Unsealed Roads** 

- Works are continuing along Thomas Plains Road with MA Skinner construction team continuing works.
- Approximately 11km unsealed roads have had vegetation cleared, been reformed and finished with a 200mm layer of PM2/20 quarry rubble, focus is on Category 1 roads as per the 5 year Transport Plan.
