

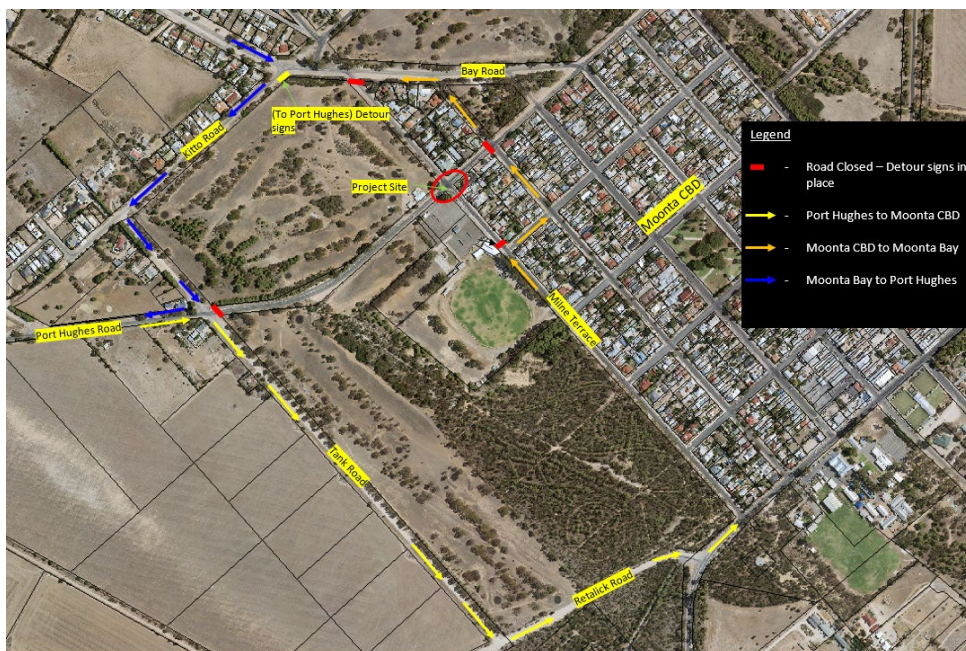
Monthly Projects Update – February 2021

Port Hughes Jetty Rehabilitation Works

- Works to reinstate 3 Bored Piles started 2nd February and were completed 9th February, with jetty reopened. Scope of works also involved reinstating decking and kerbing within sections.
- Works were completed before the scheduled 16th February completion.
- Further assessment of jetty in conjunction with Whyalla Diving Services highlighted 31 bored piles to be in a poor condition. Council is currently working with Department of Infrastructure and Transport (DIT) to progress any further inspections and remediation works.

Frances Terrace

- Stage 5 (Roundabout) Civil Works commenced 8th February.
- Tank Road (which is acting as a detour road for Port Hughes residents into Moonta) has been graded prior to Stage 5 Road Closures.
- Residents of Port Hughes area and those directly affected by the closure on Frances Terrace were notified of the inconvenience.
- Temporary road closure notice was published in the YPCT and Facebook.



Paulson Road/West Terrace, Storm Water Improvements

- A new swale drain & underground pipe work has been installed along Paulson Road to relieve storm water from West Terrace.
- Road reshaping along Paulson Road and West Terrace is progressing well, this will assist in the redirection of storm water.



Monthly Projects Update – February 2021

Wallaroo Dog Park

- Fencing, including the back fence reinstatement to a 1.8m fence (from existing 1.2m fence) complete.
- Second air lock entry/ exit complete.
- Internal asphalt footpath complete.
- Dog agility and exercise equipment installation complete.
- Council has also applied for the next round of the SA Water BYOB smart drinking water fountain program with dog bowl.



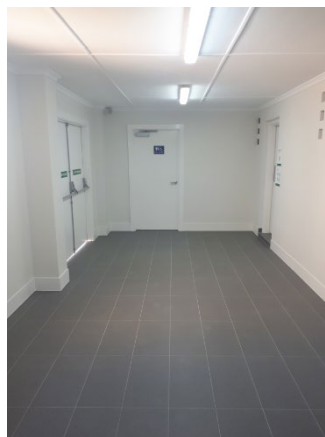
Trelawney & Gulf Street, Moonta Bay

- Underground storm water pipe, side entry pit and kerb have been completed.
- Sealing against kerb from excavation works has been completed.
- Both streets will be swept mid-February.



Wallaroo Town Hall – Upgrade

- Internal toilets are now complete.
- The supper room has been gyprocked and flushed.
- Painting is now underway with bar bench tops, carpet and blinds to be installed in the coming weeks.

- Council and Footpath contractors uncovered a buried Telstra pit, with Council working with Telstra to have pit raised to footpath finish level.
