

Monthly Projects Update – July 2021

Bay Road

- Bay Road upgrade is progressing with the Stage 3 stormwater installation, works are ongoing with excavation, pipe laying and backfilling.
- The undergrounding of power and removal of SA Power Networks stobie pole at the current shared path crossing point has been undertaken and completed.
- Council are continuing with a drone fly through to digitally track project progress and create a 3D image.
- Council continues to work with the Project Management Team, Tonkin Consulting, and the contractors collaboratively.
- A second crew to assist in the stormwater branch connections is being put together to begin works in July.



Apex Park Toilets

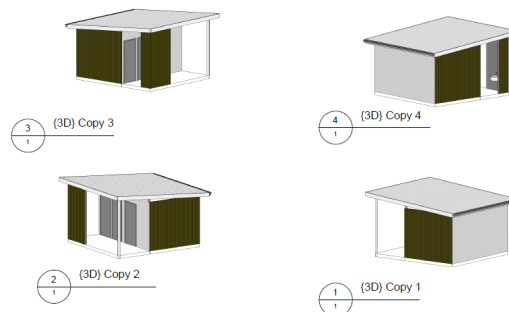
- As part of improvements to the public amenities in the Copper Coast the toilets in Apex Park, Kadina are being upgraded.
- Underfloor plumbing and concrete foundation is completed.
- Timber frames have been made off-site with installation scheduled late July subject to weather.

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Frances Terrace

- Frances Terrace concrete footpath works ongoing, Council encountered Telstra pits along the footpath that require level alterations. Council is working collaboratively with Telstra to finalise
- Milne Terrace/ Frances Terrace roundabout was closed on Thursday the 24th to Friday 25th June, splitter islands were installed and completed.



Otago Road – Sand Drift Implementation

- As part of the ongoing monitoring phase recent works have been undertaken following the recent quarterly report.
- School students, as part of a research project, assisted staff in the repair of fence netting, relocation of drifted sand and mulching.
- Staff had installed a toe dune to the southern end of Pamir Court fencing, this was to be planted out by the consulting team, however, recent high tides removed the dune before this could occur.
- Further planting was more successful within the dune system, areas that were un-vegetated and areas where sand drift had been caught by the fencing and large enough to plant into.



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East Terrace, Moonta

- Stormwater upgrades have commenced on East Terrace, which will tie into the Moonta Road stormwater upgrade following the completion here.
- The works include the creation of a detention basin, this is progressing well and nearing completion.
- Lateral drains on East Terrace between Monmouth Street and Moonta Road has commenced.
- The drainage includes undergrounding of RCP pipe connected to the detention basin as well as a swale drain on both sides of East Terrace.
- A small section of road, from Monmouth Street to Moonta Road is intended to be sealed as part of the upgrade. The seal is required to assist in stormwater run-off in this section.



North Beach Public Conveniences

- The asbestos removal on the existing North Beach toilets will take place on the 19th July 2021. All affected properties and businesses have been spoken to regarding these works.
- Frames have been built off site, once the old building has been removed foundations and underfloor plumbing work can begin.

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Moonta Cemetery

- The break during the Kernewek Festival and recent rain events has slowed progress.
- Recent attention has been on the inside wall up to the toilets near the Retallick Road side entrance.
- Focus moving forward is the outside wall of this section. There have been sections of wall in this area that have required extensive removal and replacement of unaffected rock.



Pedestrian Crossing - George Street

- New signage has been installed, garden beds and line marking completed just in time before the wet weather hit.
- To date the area has been functioning well, the crossing is being utilised and the rain gardens have been assisting in stormwater harvesting.
