Entry is Free.

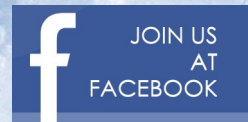

1. BALAKLAVA Courthouse Gallery   <p>A community run venue in central Balaklava. Look out for the annual Balco Art Prize exhibition. Air-conditioned gallery & gift shop. Wheelchair access. The historic Balaklava Courthouse was converted into an Art Gallery & Gift Shop when offered to the community. Since the Gallery opened in 1991, the community has enjoyed regular exhibitions by S.A. artists & craft people.</p>	2. PORT WAKEFIELD Salt Of The Earth Café   <p>Primarily a popular café near the wharf at Port Wakefield, the venue also shows local art & designs in the adjacent gallery. Open for a fine selection of foods & beverages for dine in or take away, as well as selling arts and crafts. Salt of the earth Café offers quaint heritage listed buildings surrounded by a beautifully maintained garden.</p>	3. BUTE Gunner Bill's Gallery   <p>Located in the small farming town of Bute is the beautifully restored Gunner Bill's Gallery, full of quality craft & art. Formerly the Bute Police Station, the building was opened in 1911 & consisted of a residence for the Police Officer and family, a courthouse, cells & horse stables. Incorporated into the Gallery is the Historical Museum which houses police memorabilia and the history of YP Swagmen</p>	4. PORT BROUGHTON Palate2Palette   <p>Restaurant—Art Gallery Great value art works from established and emerging SA artists Quality food, wine, coffee, tea and cakes Local seafood, authentic Asian, traditional pasta and daily specials Great service, family friendly atmosphere Alfresco dining area with views of the bay Live music first sunday of the month</p>	5. KADINA Ascot Theatre   <p>The Ascot Building is opened by volunteer staff of the Copper Country Keepsakes, who have a wonderful collection of quality art and craft for sale. The cultural centre serves the Copper Coast community with performing and visual art activities. The art gallery features artworks acquired through the Cornish Festival Art competitions and hosts many travelling exhibitions.</p>	6. KADINA Chatswood Studio   <p>Artist in residence Pat Brereton works in water-colour, pastel and other mediums. Drop in for a good old fashioned chat and cuppa with Pat and Colin. The studio is filled with beautiful pieces of artwork and Pat also specialises in framing her paintings</p>	7. KADINA Picturesque Framing & Gallery   <p>Custom framing service done to the highest of professional standards. The gallery boasts a range of artwork to suit all tastes & decor. Grand to petite; oils, acrylic, pastels, watercolours. Notable, award winning artists' works on show. There are many unframed artworks & photos which make wonderful gifts, great for travellers or just to store away to frame & show another day.</p>	8. WALLAROO Artspot Gallery   <p>Versatility is what Wallaroo artist, Roy Purcell, is known for – & his choices vary from abstract to portrait & anything that catches his eye as a workable subject. Roy's gallery, The Art Spot, has over 100 works on display. Roy's gallery is open any day inc. public holidays. A phone call may be needed for days other than Friday, Saturday, Sunday & public holidays. Bus trips welcome, tea and coffee can be provided by prior arrangement.</p>	9. MOONTA Gallery Of The Arts   <p>The Moonta Gallery of The Arts is housed in the original council chamber rooms at the Moonta Town Hall, built in 1885. It is a community gallery, run by volunteers and supported by the District Council of the Copper Coast. Exhibitions change monthly, with regular themed community exhibitions, and others showcasing individual artists.</p>
10. MOONTA Queen Square Art Group   <p>NYP Art Group is a visual art group based at Moonta who meet every Tuesday from 10am to 2pm at Moonta in the Uniting Church. They run workshops, hold exhibitions, run a gallery at Moonta Town & on long weekends & even have art camps! Members range from experienced professionals to beginners & use a variety of mediums. Visitors are most welcome to visit.</p>	11. MOONTA BAY Henriette's Studio & Gallery   <p>Henriette has been painting for 9 years using acrylics, pastels or oils, specialising in Outdoor Art on metal for patios or entertainment areas. Her work is on display at Queen Square Art Gallery. Henriette has won several prizes at shows & exhibitions. Henriette's Art Studio/Gallery is open most weekend</p>	12. MAITLAND Maitland Markets Bob Landt's Corner Gallery   <p>Robert Landt paints as a recognised professional artist. Generous with his knowledge, Bob teaches art & is on the board of the Royal S.A. Society of Arts & editor for the society's magazine "Kalori". Bob's watercolours have won many awards & he has works in collections both in Australia & overseas. ARDROSSAN Blue Crab Studio Gallery Cafe   <p>A working artists studio and gallery in central Ardrossan with a variety of local artists works on display set in a unique café with a range of local produce & designs. Serving their own premium coffee beans in a relaxing family friendly atmosphere. Hosted by resident artist Sam Carter</p>	14. ARDROSSAN Peterson Fine Art   <p>Hosted by talented father/son combination Phil & Kristian Peterson, the working Artist Studio also has its own gallery. Phil was the winner of the Award for a Work by a Resident of the District Council of the Yorke Peninsula at the 2012 YP Art Show. Kristian is a creative stencil and aerosol artist.</p>	15. MINLATON Harvest Corner Gallery YP Visitor Centre   <p>Located in the multi award winning, fully accredited YP visitor centre, the gallery is the largest permanent exhibition of local artisans and includes basket weaving, wood turning, ceramics and pottery as well as works by well known local artists, including Allyson Parsons. A magnificent display of superb locally made crafts makes visiting Harvest Corner a delightful affair, we encourage you to linger in the tearooms or chat with our volunteers</p>	16. WAROOKA Wellness On Yorke's   <p>A natural therapy & alternative therapy business set in Warooka's Main Street offering a range of interesting local craft and souvenirs. Displaying photographic artwork by talented locals Steph Ball and Jasmine Saint. Life-long resident near Warooka, Steph enjoys creating digital art with photographic images she has taken of the countryside surrounding her home.</p>	17. YORKETOWN Salt Lake's Gallery   <p>The Telecentre has local arts and craft in an information centre venue. The opening of the Salt Lakes Gallery has provided an outlet for local artisans, the opportunity for visitors & the local community to access unique gifts. These include hand-made candles, jewellery, knitted toys, art, ceramics, furniture, cards, metal art, the finest produce, and so much more – really worth the visit.</p>	18. EDITHBURGH Edithburgh Artisan   <p>Home to the Heel 'n Soul Art Group the venue has a wide range of local talent on display. The result of hard work by many, inspired & encouraged by the coming to town of a small shop on Blanche St: Edithburgh Artisan. The artists have made work to die for. Masses of beautiful silver & sea glass jewellery, lovely pots, hand made paper & books, divine hats, & gifts from the sea, to complement.</p>

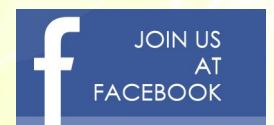
