Port Hughes Jetty Rehabilitation Works

- Bored pile reinstatement works along Port Hughes Jetty complete and the Jetty reopened ahead of schedule on the 12th of February.
- Further assessment of the jetty, in conjunction with DIT, to be undertaken in March.
- Whyalla Diving Services have undertaken an underwater assessment of the entire jetty in preparation for this joint inspection.



Frances Terrace

- Stage 5 (Roundabout) Civil Works commenced on 8th February
- Underground storm water works have progressed well and are scheduled for completion the end of February.
- Underground lighting works and conduit laying underway
- Kerb preparation and reinstatement works set to commence from early March 2021.





Wallaroo Dog Park

- Dog agility and exercise equipment installation complete.
- Fountain tap installation works complete.
- Parks and garden staff completing the vegetation and irrigation system.
- The Rotary club are set to install a shelter and seating within the dog park.





<u>Cemetery</u>

- Council staff have removed the dirt and rubbish from the outer wall.
- Contractor has commenced the masonry repair process on the required walls.
- Initial investigations have determined the extent of repairs to not be as involved as Kadina Cemetery.









Paulson Road/West Tce, Storm Water Improvements


- Swale drain & underground pipe works have been completed.
- Road reshaping for stormwater flows have been completed.
- A small detention basin along Lipson Avenue for the stormwater collection has been created.
- Small amount of vegetation and a rubble access path will be included to complete this project.



<u>Wallaroo Town Hall – Upgrade</u>

- Joinery upgrade completed to the servery counter.
- Electrical reinstatement and painting completed including the addition of two reverse cycle air-conditioners.
- Carpets installed and final touches are being put in place before a reopening.





Footpaths

- Drain Road footpath installation works from Copper Coast Highway to George Street complete with only Telstra pit extents outstanding
- Telstra scheduled to raise pits on 22nd February.





Port Hughes Dredge

- Dredging, under EPA License, occurred during the 22nd February to 5th March.
- Council staff undertook the scheduled dredge as this proved a more cost effective approach.
- Large amounts of seaweed and sand were removed from the mouth and by the offload/service ramp.









Native Bee BnB's

- Council in conjunction with the Northern and Yorke Landscape Board and the Australian Plant Society- Northern and Yorke have been successful in grant funding for 8 native bee 'hotels' to be placed in various locations in Moonta, Wallaroo and Kadina in 'bee' friendly gardens.
- Two workshops will also take place in April at the Australian Plant Society- Northern and Yorke in Kadina and the Community Activity Centre in Moonta with bee expert Dr Katja Hogendoorn.
